Student Policies/Responsibilities for performers and floor crew

1. Follow itinerary and be **on time**.
2. Be **respectful** of all chaperones/staff and report any concerns to the Director.
3. Performers wear **make-up** and **hair** as instructed by the Director.
4. Leaders will assist in **checking all equipment**, uniforms, etc. Performers are to be responsible for their own equipment and uniform.
5. Always **remain with the group** and chaperones.
6. Wear **full uniform** as designed, or be completely covered with sweatsuit, etc.
7. **No eating** in uniform unless all students have been granted permission.
8. File into show together and **sit in an organized manner** in the stands.
9. **Floor crew** should sit together in a group by the unit, unless working with the props.
10. There is to be **no unnecessary talking** when filing to warm-up or in transit in between until performance is complete.
11. After a performance, **re-count** and pack the equipment.
12. **No PDA**-type interactions while in uniform or with the group.
13. Always be **gracious** when discussing other units and accepting scores at a show.
14. **Never take any chances** when it comes to safety or causing damage to yourself, others or facilities.
15. All rules typical of the **Student Code of Conduct** apply when participating with the guard. *All students are expected to use proper language. Any student removing items from hotel rooms will be referred for theft. Any student found in a hotel room occupied by the opposite sex may be referred for sexual harassment. Any student found to be carrying any knives, etc. will be turned over to resource officers for a weapons charge. Any student found to be in the possession of illegal drugs, tobacco or alcohol will be referred to the CHS Discipline Office, regardless of age.*

Parent/Chaperone Policies/Responsibilities

1. **Supervise students' safety** and direct students away from potential danger.
2. **Escort students** to locker rooms or vehicles, etc.
3. **Assist Director** with tasks necessary to achieve a successful experience.
4. **Encourage** your own child's performance at home or in private.
5. **Inspect hotel rooms** for damage prior to allowing students to occupy a room and after students have packed and checked out.
6. **Police areas** in which we practice for any trash and leave sites "better than we found them."
7. Assist in **loading** and **unloading** of floor, props, etc.
8. Respect the **no talking policy** during the warm-up process including the holding area.
9. **Do not make comments** to the total group related to performance skills.
10. **Do not reprimand students** based on hair, make-up, uniform, etc.
11. **Report** policy infractions to the Director.
12. **Don't smoke in front of students** and there is **no drinking** of alcohol on CWG trips.
13. Make sure you have filed a **Volunteer Form** with CHS and been **screened** by OCSD for category 2 clearance involving fingerprinting for overnight trips.
